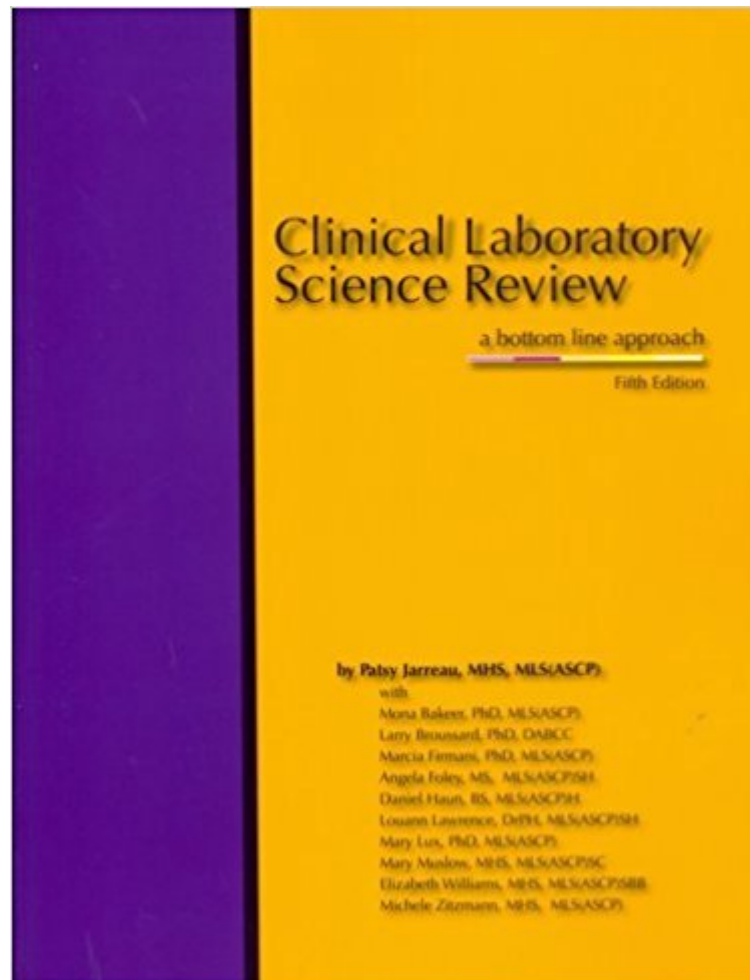

This is a good review if you like acronyms. There are simple ones that you will never forget and there are more complex ones that may or may not help you. The best way to use this book is to study the material in the ASCP BOC study guide or the MLS review by Robert Harr (excellent) prior to learning quick acronyms. In other words, your knowledge base should be well rounded before using this book so that you understand concepts and are not just memorizing facts.

I think this review will mainly be helpful for the individuals who find acronyms and mnemonics helpful. I discovered that unfortunately I am not one of those people. For me, I would remember the little rhyme but not what it stood for. Despite that though, this is a fairly good review that can be used to reinforce the important bits that will be covered on the ASCP MLS exam.
