"Smitten Book Club" is an ideally written book about four single women who have been friends for years and have a meeting of a book club in which they come together to discuss the book at the meeting. Each woman has read the book so she comes prepared to share her thoughts. All four women work in Smitten, Vermont. (Smitten is the invention of the four authors of this book, and others in the Smitten series.) Each store or business is an expression of each individual, and the whole town is neighbors helping each other in varied situations. Knowing this, and the bond among Heather, Abby, Lea, and Molly, makes for a very lively story, as each woman meets and falls in love with a Smitten resident. We watch each woman's relationship develop with each man, but the best part of this novel is that the story is put together by four authors who each have one woman to develop. All four women are intertwined in the other authors' part of the book, and it is well edited and written. This is a very lively Christian novel.

It's difficult to review four short stories at the same time. I am in the minority with my review, but, in my opinion, all four lack interesting characters, the stories are a bit silly.
