

We checked this out from the library for a test drive on a week long vacation. Bought the book with no hesitation. We even take it with us on weekend trips in case we have to change plans because the campground is full. For the most part the book gives you an idea of what you will find when you get there. Size and type of camper, tents only, water, trash, general info on the campground and area. This is not in the book but if you camp near a big city on Friday or Saturday expect a lot of noise maker types in the campground. Pack earplugs.

We like this book. We actually thought we were getting the updated fourth edition rather than the original version - which we already have. Guess we should have paid closer attention to what we were getting - now we have duplicates.

This book has great maps of the camp-grounds, prices and services available that we have seen. We have a small travel trailer and sometimes its hard to know if we can access a particular camp ground, but this book makes it easy. It's our main reference book when camping in Colorado
