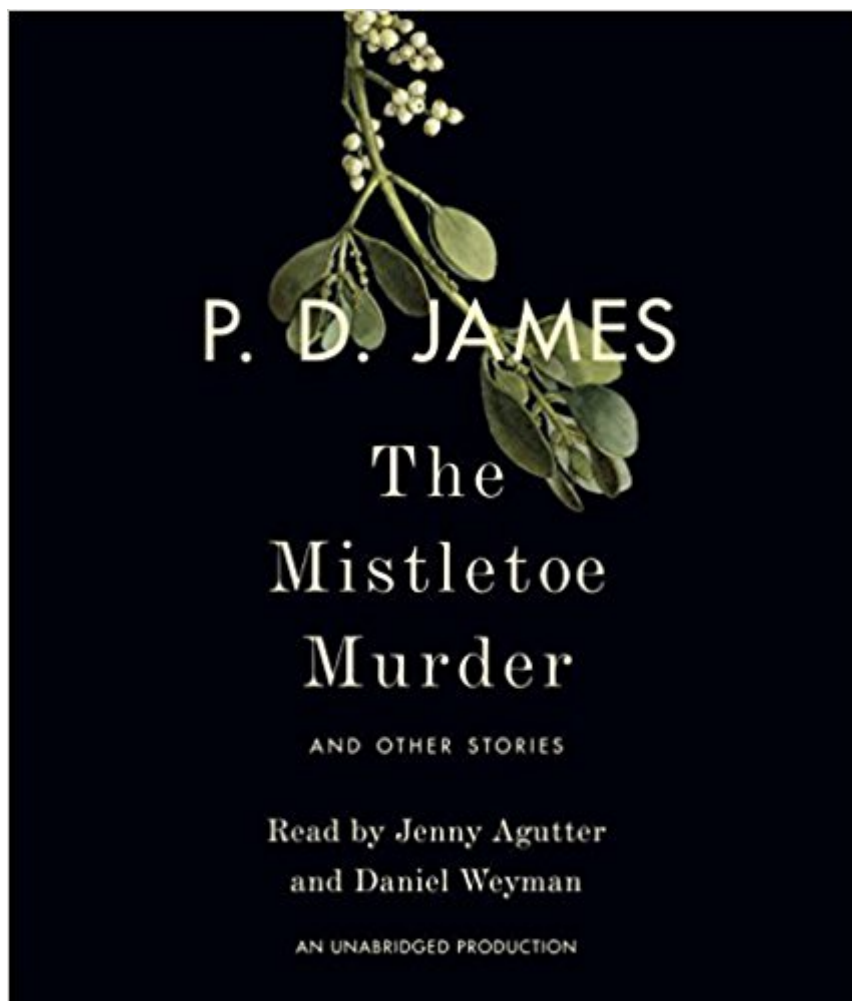


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The Mistletoe Murder: And Other Stories



Synopsis

The newly appointed Sgt. Dalgliesh is drawn into a case that is "pure Agatha Christie." . . . P. D. JAMES was the author of twenty-one books, many of which feature her detective hero Adam Dalgliesh and have been televised or filmed. She was the recipient of many honors, including the Mystery Writers of America Grandmaster Award and the National Arts Club Medal of Honor for Literature, and in 1991 was created Baroness James of Holland Park. This little gem is an enjoyable collection of four short stories from the late P.D. James, a master (mistress?) of the genre. Three of them were set at Christmas and two featured a young Adam Dalgliesh, so was an excellent choice for a pleasurable Christmas holiday read.

PD James at her best!

I felt "cheated" by this book. It was an equivalent price to one of PD James (usually) excellent books but this only contained 4 "quite flimsy" short stories. While each had a nice twist at the end, that's the best I can say about it.
