

As you might hope from a Mr. Robot book, this is a lovingly designed and written glimpse into the Mr. Robot world thru the notebook Elliot maintained and referenced on the show. The care and detail in the design, feel, hand writing, and inserts is truly impressive. This is not some gimmick. Like the show, there are multiple depths you can take it, along with puzzles and clues. If you are a serious fan of the show, you will appreciate the tactile and mental experience.

This book is awesome. There are a ton of puzzles, some I got right away some that I'm sure I won't be able to solve without help from the internet. Make sure you've seen all of season 2 before reading the book though there are some spoilers

I absolutely adore this notebook. It all seems so personal to read. Almost like you are invading Elliot's privacy. If you are a fan of Mr. Robot and have already watched season 2 this journal is a MUST have. I will admit though the narration really adds to the overall appeal of the story. There is extra commentary with the narration that you will not get by just reading the book itself. I truly believe that my experience with the journal changed after I downloaded the narration for free off audible( your first book is free). It really helped me understand Elliot's complex character a bit more and for this show that may be as close as we're going to get. Honestly I was thrilled to read it.

This book is great. It comes with a ton of tiny details and trinkets, adds to the plot in ways you might not have noticed in the show, and helps paint a better image of Elliot's mind instead of just what he wants you to see, friend. If you watch the show you should buy it. I wonder what he used the red wheelbarrow to move?

This book is amazing! As a huge fan of the show I am absolutely in love with the book! It takes place after season 1, through the several month gap between the seasons, and into the season 2. So its probably best to wait to read this until after watching all of season 1 and 2 so as not to spoil anything. **SEASON 1 AND 2 SPOILERS!!!!** The plot follows Elliot Alderson an antisocial, mentally unstable, hacker, who has just taken part in hacking the biggest conglomerate in the world and effectively put in motion a major redistribution of wealth that will equalize the classes and knock the big wig millionaires down a notch; but it didn't quite work out as planned. Now that things have not turned out perfectly and Elliot who had been having second thoughts has no memory of the night he initiated the hack, and his alter ego/dead imaginary father figure Mr. Robot refuses to tell him what happened. Following the hack which is called the 5/9 Hack, Elliot is arrested and sent to jail for a hack he did against his therapists boyfriend, which resulted in Elliot taking the mans dog, Flipper and forcing him to reveal that he was cheating on his wife and using a fake name to see Krista, Elliot's therapist. During Elliot's stay in jail he keeps a journal, that he names Red Wheelbarrow, and writes in everyday several times a day to keep track of his movements and to monitor if Mr. Robot takes over leaving him with gaps in his memory. This journal delves into Elliot's mind in a way the show couldn't, it develops his character incredibly and really blurs the line between fiction and reality. This journal brings you through his struggles with Mr. Robot becoming violent towards him and the difficulties he faces simply as a lone prisoner dealing with gangs and other inmates. **END OF SPOILERS** So in conclusion if you enjoy the show and are interested in delving a little deeper into the mind of Elliot then this book is a must buy. The fact that it's written by the shows creator Sam Esmail means Elliot truly comes alive in the pages and there is no disconnect between the version of Elliot in the TV show and the version seen in this book.

If you're like me, you looked for clues and puzzles throughout season 2 and played along with the online ARG. The series is filled with codes, puzzles, phone numbers, QR codes, and much more and this book continues that standard. It is not only crafted perfectly and looks like an authentic comp book, it is filled with removable items that can be decoded and contain secret messages between Mr Robot and the dark army. The story that takes part in the book takes place prior to and during the events of season 2 and offer some really cool insight into Elliot's mind and his interactions with other inmates during his time in jail. This is essential material for any real fan, the average fan might not be as entertained but it is still a really cool book to own.
