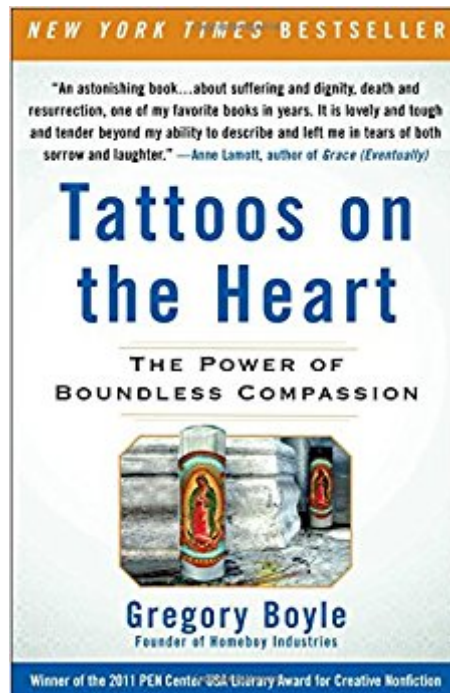




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Tattoos On The Heart: The Power Of Boundless Compassion



Synopsis

For twenty years, Gregory Boyle has run Homeboy Industries, a gang-intervention program located in the Boyle Heights neighborhood of Los Angeles, the gang capital of the world. In *Tattoos on the Heart*, he distills his experience working in the ghetto into a breathtaking series of parables inspired by faith. Arranged by theme and filled with sparkling humor and glowing generosity, these essays offer a stirring look at how full our lives could be if we could find the joy in loving others and in being loved unconditionally. From giant, tattooed Cesar, shopping at JCPenney fresh out of prison, we learn how to feel worthy of God's love. From ten-year-old Lula we learn the importance of being known and acknowledged. From Pedro we understand the kind of patience necessary to rescue someone from the darkness. In each chapter we benefit from Boyle's gentle, hard-earned wisdom. These essays about universal kinship and redemption are moving examples of the power of unconditional love and the importance of fighting despair. Gorgeous and uplifting, *Tattoos on the Heart* reminds us that no life is less valuable than another.

In this artful, disquieting, yet surprisingly jubilant memoir, Jesuit priest Boyle recounts his two decades of working with homies in Los Angeles County, which contains 1,100 gangs with nearly 86,000 members. Boyle's Homeboy Industries is the largest gang intervention program in the country, offering job training, tattoo removal, and employment to members of enemy gangs. Effectively straddling the debate regarding where the responsibility for urban violence lies, Boyle both recounts the despair of watching the kids you love cooperate in their own demise and

levels the challenge to readers to stand in awe at what the poor have to carry rather than stand in judgment at how they carry it. From moving vignettes about gangsters breaking into tears or finding themselves worthy of love and affirmation, to moments of spiritual reflection and sidesplittingly funny banter between him and the homies, Boyle creates a convincing and even joyful treatise on the sacredness of every life. Considering that he has buried more than 150 young people from gang-related violence, the joyful tenor of the book remains an astounding literary and spiritual feat. (Mar.) A different perspective on ministry. I felt it was worthwhile donating my copy to the local seminary so that the seminarians could get some knowledge of the costs and contributions afforded them in this particular area of ministry. Working with people, i.e., young men and women, who have chosen a wrong road and need to be set on a more productive path has its costs and rewards. This presentation, and life itself, is not a perfect balance of good and bad. Successes are to be celebrated, but it takes time and effort. The cost of laying 180 of your parish members, in this case warehouse employees, to rest is heart wrenching, meaning successes are that much more precious.

Author is a GENUINE Christian who has been extremely effective in showing love to those never loved in childhood (IF they want help from theirself-destructive lifestyles), AND he helped them create highly successful work settings for themselves (largest tattoo removal center in the world, silkscreen business, a bakery, cafe and ? more). He has focused on L.A. gang members, men and women. He is now internationally known where he speaks all over the world, and a large number of American cities with gang problems have tried to create similar programs in the USA. He is also a well-read Jesuit who quoted more than 90 philosophers, etc in his book.

I was sad when I came to the last page. I read a story every night, and went to sleep with a hopeful heart. I am waiting for Stephen Boyle's next book to be published.

This book was selected as the mandatory summer read by a local Catholic High School. It is a powerful description of life and quite often death in one of America's toughest neighborhoods. The Jesuit priest who wrote the book, talks about his seemingly futile efforts to change the outcome. The characters he encountered wanted change but had no idea how to start. Some of them changed, but often died, but not without achieving a spiritual success. The scary part is relating it to the life we have in our protected world of suburban America. The author show us how.

This with make you laugh and cry, sometimes at the same time. Have tissues nearby because you will likely need them. The stories gave me new appreciation for what it must be like to live in and near gang culture and for how fragile life is. I loved seeing the shift in Fr. Greg Boyle as he moved from his world and learned how to become most effective in his very important work. Would it be fair to call him the Mother Teresa of gangs in LA? Homeboy Industries/Homegirl Cafe also sells their cookbook which my daughter loves. She volunteered with them during 2 spring breaks in college and loved the food and experience. I look forward to the sequel of Tattoos on the Heart.

This is a wonderful story of faith struggling with reality and the dogged determination of a priest who absolutely will not give up. He does an amazing job of taking the reader into the streets of East L.A., Boyle Heights and the surrounding area. He is a fascinating emissary of God. He never waivers in his convictions although driven to his knees in a desperate struggle to save just one more soul before gang violence steals what he has tried to save. He knows gang members and understands their philosophy. I spent 28 years as an L.A. County Deputy Sheriff. I'm familiar with the streets and the people the priest writes about. Listen to it on CD or you'll miss the voice inflection, jargon, and verisimilitude that is truly East L.A.

This is a very moving story of Greg Boyle's work with gang members who want a better life for themselves and their families. His love, acceptance, and encouragement help them to make the journey. Very inspirational.

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
