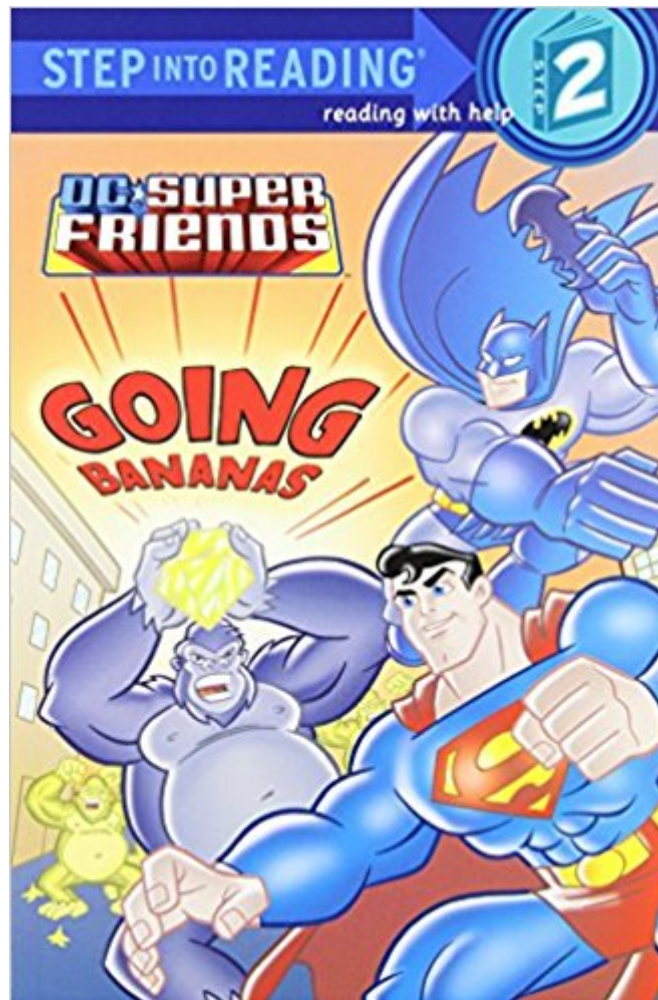

Second, the Green Lantern traps some of the magical, yellow gorillas with a net from his ring. Come on, who's writing this story? Anyone who has read anything about Green Lantern knows he cannot affect yellow objects.PS. The Green Lantern is John Stewart, not Kyle Rayner, so no explanation for affecting yellow there.
