While I love a lot of Living Languages' courses like, Ultimate Arabic, Ultimate Spanish, the whole Spoken World series, these earlier basic versions really suck. This is the most boring language book I own and I own a *lot* of language books. The lay out is confusing and discombobulated. I have been trying for a month to get thru it and it is soooooo BORING, I have yet to get past the first chapter, page 3. I got this on someone recommending it to me and I am sorry I listened to him

because this course is a big disappointment. It has so much grammar per chapter, you give up before you begin from absolute terror of reading it and nodding off. The way they try to teach you is stuffing your head with so much information at one time, you can't wrap your head around it. The first chapter is so intimidating and that follows throughout the whole book. They spend more time explaining sentence structure and grammar in each chapter, there is little dialog and little else. I think that maybe, just maybe I might feel differently if I had another course under my belt and I understood Japanese a bit better but as a beginner basics course, that to me, is not true. No beginner could really do this unless they have a head--and love, for grammar and sentence structure explanations. I can't complain too hard, fortunately I got it used for 10 bucks so its little money lost and a lesson learned. I will come back and update later maybe my opinion will change but for now, if you are a beginner that hates grammar, sentence structure and detailed explanations, then avoid this book like Typhoid Mary and come back to it later. If you LOVE grammar, and that type of thing, this course is right up your alley.

The course was as affirming as it was informative in explaining conversational Japanese. I have through this course a few times and compared with Japanese language courses and textbooks and it is the one course I go to when I am tripped up in my language acquisition. The living language "system" that is stairway of sorts of learning words, repeating phrases, making sentences, and ultimately having conversations on par with following a math algorithm - "x ga arimasu" (there is x) or "y ni x ga imasu" (there is x in y). In fact, the course makes heavy use of algebraic formulas to help the reader make sentences. While the course consists of forty lessons, the actual lessons are further divided into two 'sublessons' that kind of compliment one another - Lesson 15 that introduces the "-te form or verbs" is coupled with lesson about the progressive form of verbs. All Japanese is in romanji. The lessons are simple as they can be and the quizzes are just difficult enough to give the absolute beginner a sense of progress. Compared with other editions of the Living Language series, I would have to say it offers a balance of good instructional content, encouraging results and price. If the reader has the time, they may want to compare my reviews on the 1993 and 2012 editions - in the simplest form, this is an improvement to the 1993 edition and copied verbatim to the 2012 edition, which may not be as disreputable as you might think. It does have some flaws though - there are some minor printing mistakes that do not reconcile explanations and conjugation tables, though by the time they appear, even I could tell something was off. The course only focuses the conversational element and after introducing the syllabary first lesson, it never elaborates the written form. The box seems to hype *.MP3 compatibility, which I suppose is

their tacit acknowledgement that will most likely rip the included CDs to your audio player.
