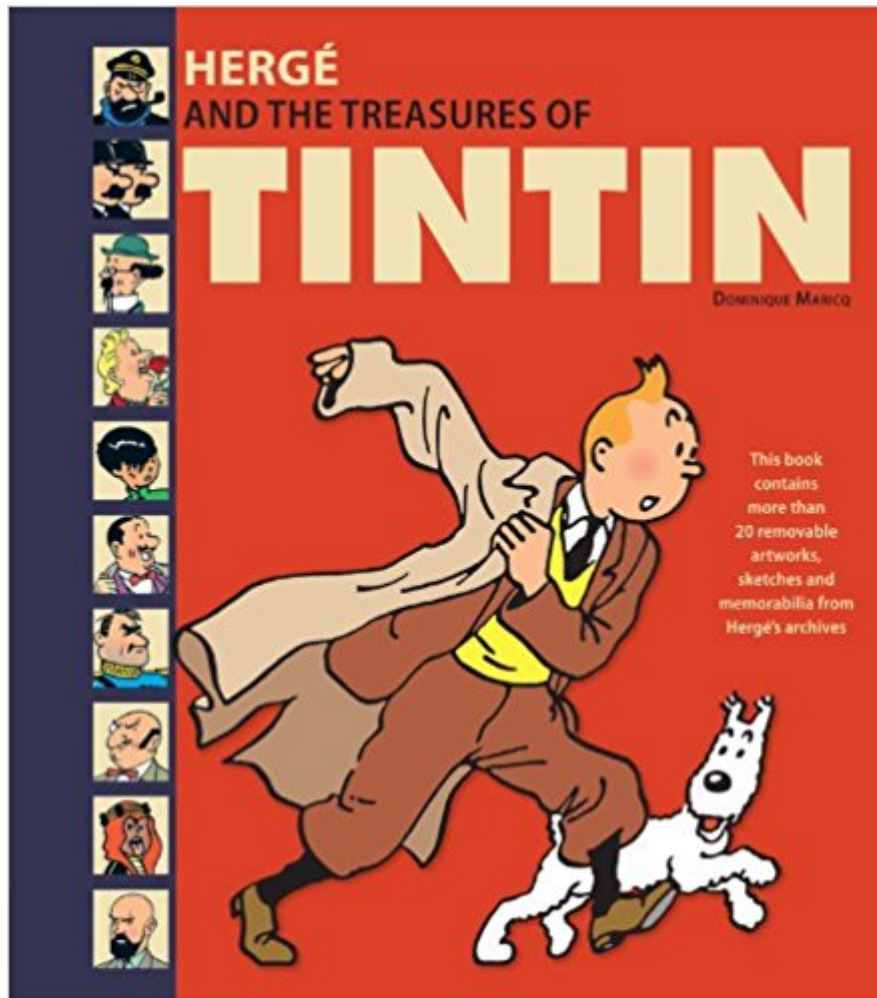

I just received this book yesterday after pre-ordering it and must say it's a must have for all Tintin Fans. I own all books recently published in English about Tintin and Hergé and this one makes a great addition to my collection. Published by Éditions moulinesart and written by Dominique Maricq an archivist at Studios Hergé book this book beautifully presented with a cushioned cover and high quality paper and printing. The book is divided into four sections after a brief introduction. 1. 1929-1940 From Spontaneity to Mastery 2. 1940-1944 The golden Age 3. 1946-1960 Maturity 4. 1960-1983 A Legend is Established There is also a conclusion with the title "Hergé Thirty Years Later". Each section has a subsection dealing with each Tintin Adventure and gives between four

and six small paragraphs of information as well as illustrations many of which I have not seen before. This is pretty amazing because I own eight books on Tintin, and I thought I had pretty much seen it all. An extra bonus is that in six pockets the book contains a total of 22 facsimiles of drawings, posters, greeting cards, vignettes, announcements etc. (One word of warning, some of the are difficult to put back in the envelopes due to tight fits, so take extra care to keep them in pristine condition) So, if you like Tintin, You should really get this book before it goes out of print.
