

PreS-Gr. 2. From the first close-up of an animal's eye and part of its face, this entertaining book will have children wanting to "guess who I am." Each of eight foldouts opens to reveal a different, familiar animal--among them, a wolf, a turtle, a frog, and a skunk. The critter's name is printed in large, dark type in the upper right-hand corner of the spread, the text supplies a few bonus facts, and each illustration offers a glimpse of the next animal featured. In the raccoon spread, for example, children can see the tips of a bobcat's ears. The final foldout is especially rewarding; it includes a "hidden pictures" tableau of all eight animals in a wood around a lake. As author and illustrator of this guessing game, I must admit it is probably my favorite from over 20 books I have created. I researched many animals to include and narrowed it down to eight that would exist in a typical North American habitat : duck, turtle, frog, raccoon, bobcat, mouse, owl, and

wolf. The child would guess what the animal is by reading the simple words and looking at the eyes of the critter. Lifting the flap reveals the animal in its habitat in either daytime,Â sundown, or night. I was so pleased to have the art of this book and my Animals in Camouflage (another guessing book) used to create the entrance and interactive decorations in the North Royalton Library's wing in Ohio.
