

Anna Dewdney was a teacher, mother, and enthusiastic proponent of reading aloud to children. She continually honed her skills as an artist and writer and published her first Llama Llama book in 2005. Her passion for creating extended to home and garden and she lovingly restored an 18th century farmhouse in southern Vermont. She wrote, painted, gardened, and lived there with her partner, Reed, her two daughters, two wirehaired pointing griffons, and one bulldog. Anna passed away in 2016, but her spirit will live on in her books.

My daughter has loved all the Llama Llama books since she was 6 months old, she is now 14 months. The rhyming text flows easily and the pictures keep her excited and engaged. The book takes less than a minute to read, but with a baby/toddler they can't attend for much longer. I bought this book as a gift for a friend and she also enjoys the Llama Llama series.

My girls are 3 and 1 - they LOVE Llama Llama books. I don't particularly love the board books as much as the regular books because the text is rather short and there really isn't much to the story, but as I mentioned my girls LOVE these books so I'd rather they have lots of books to look at.

My little one enjoys the Llama Llama books. This one made for a great Halloween gift. Short and sweet book that helped to prepare her for trick or treating and masks we might encounter. Cute illustrations and not scary for the little ones.

My family loves the Llama books! This board book is definitely geared towards a smaller child. I got it for my one year old to read to him at Halloween. My older son (6) enjoyed listening to me read it to his brother but it definitely not something he would pick up on his own. The book is a sturdy board book, the pictures are wonderful. Anna Dewdney did another great job! If you have a little Llama fan they will definitely need to add this book to their collection.

Pictures are very cute. I bought this when my child was just 1, but even then we thought there was too little content. Overall love Llama Llama books though.

I got my little one a Halloween costume. She loves fish, so it was a Nemo costume. She refused to wear it! I guess she figured that it looked very different than what she wore everyday. I had to think of a way to get her to wear the costume, or any costume for that matter. She does like books, so I ordered this book. She loved it! She could recite it 4 days later. A month later, she still asks for it by name. And yes, she did wear a costume for Halloween.

These books are short and I wish they were a page or two longer or with more dialogue because my son loves them. Basically Llama is getting ready to trick or treat for Halloween and at the end he says Llama Llama Trick or Treat! There isn't more to say, but I think they are worth the money because we read it over and over and over and....

Fun Halloween book. I have purchased several Llama Llama books for my grandson. He is only 1 year old but loves the Llama Llama books. They have colorful pictures that keep his attention, and the wording is simple and catchy enough to hold his interest. He has several books in his collection but always picks a Llama Llama book to bring to me when he wants to read a book.
