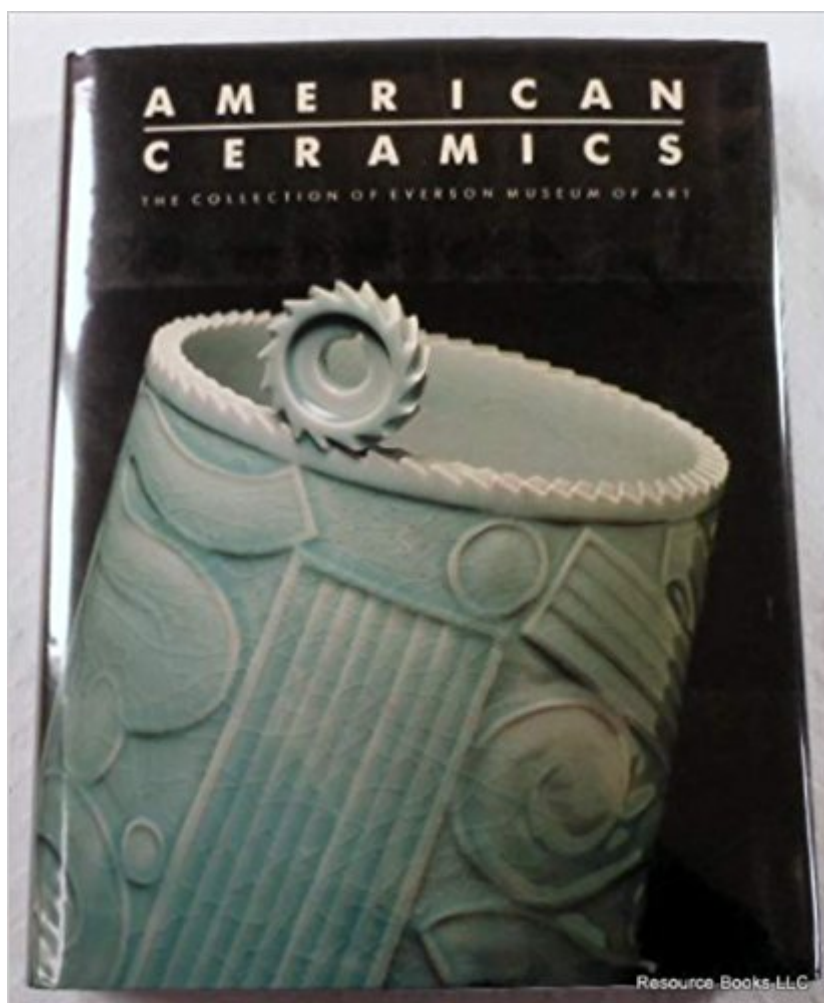


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American Ceramics: The Collection Of Everson Museum Of Art
