I did have a couple of issues with this book. There are a number of blatant typos and a few minor inconsistencies. But the main reason I only gave it four stars was because the ending felt rushed and incomplete. I really hope there will be a sequel because I felt like it was building up to something bigger and I want to know what happens to Ella and Ethan after they finish school.

I do wish that the ending had a little more to it and that the typos were corrected (but I could get past the 5 typos I actually picked up).
