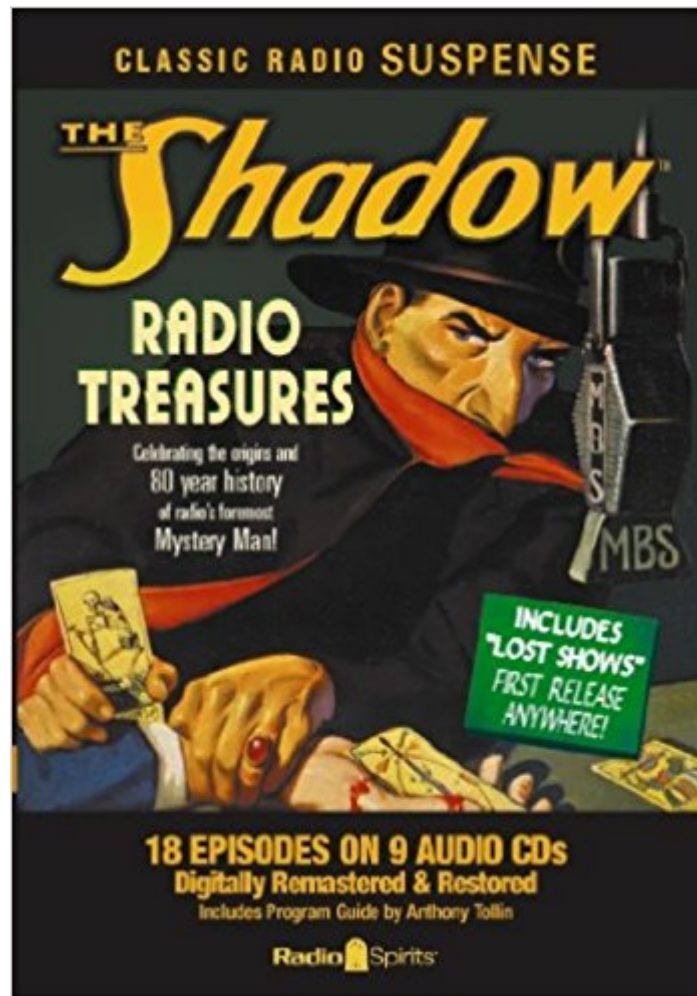

This is a wonderfully entertaining collection of radio shows. The sound quality is a little uneven (as to be expected from broadcasts nearly a century old) but in some ways that actually adds to the atmosphere. These shows have made my morning commute much more pleasant. And thanks to the inclusion of the original sponsor's commercials I know more about heating my home with anthracite blue coal than any of co-workers!
