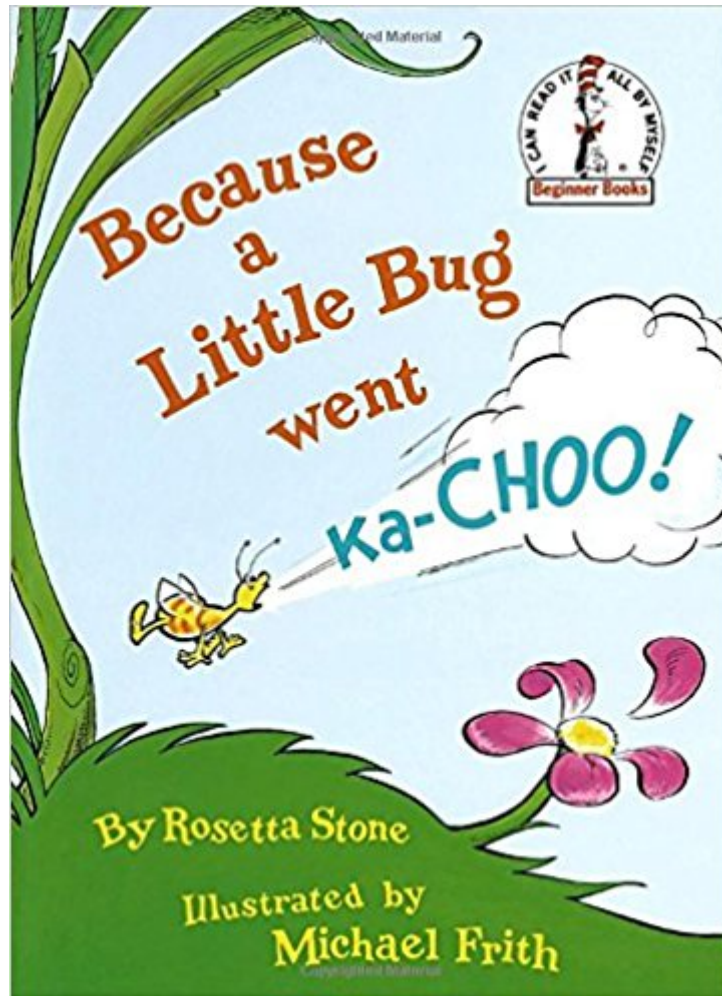

Theodor Seuss Geisel - better known to millions of his fans as Dr. Seuss - was born the son of a park superintendent in Springfield, Massachusetts, in 1904. After studying at Dartmouth College, New Hampshire, and later at Oxford University in England, he became a magazine humorist and cartoonist, and an advertising man. He soon turned his many talents to writing children's books, and

his first book - And To Think That I Saw It On Mulberry Street - was published in 1937. His greatest claim to fame was the one and only The Cat in the Hat, published in 1957, the first of a hugely successful range of early learning books known as Beginner Books. --This text refers to an out of print or unavailable edition of this title.

Out of his first books as a toddler, this was my son's favorite. He is now a grown man with a family of his own, but he still remembers the times when my wife and I read this story to him with enthusiasm and play acting. That is why we like to pass a copy of it along as baby shower gifts when possible. It is a simple story with a big message, even the small things that we do or that happen around us can have big consequences.

I received this book when I was a young child, I'm 36 now and it is still a beloved classic in our family. I now purchase this book as gifts for all the kids in my life. My four-year-old thinks it is hilarious the calamity that occurs from a bug sneezing.
