

This the third book in the Destiny's Crucible Series is well worth reading if you enjoyed the first two books as much as I did. This book primarily focuses on building the support and logistics structure needed to win the war, so only about 10% of the book deals fighting. I'm glad the author took the

time to cover these less glorious aspects of military conflict, since too many books fail to make the attempt, and it demonstrates a better them average understanding on the topic by the author. The book ended with an intriguing introduction of a new faction to the growing conflict, which leads me to speculate on what will happen next and wishing for the next book. I did have one minor problem with this book, the story cut back a couple of times to a previous time, leaving me momentarily confused. I feel like the time line could have been handled better. Four and a half stars.

I'm using this review for all 3 books. First, I got the first book thinking it would be "OK", "decent", etc. How unbelievably stupid of me! These books are excellent. Not your usual "got thrown back in time or moved to another world, built fighter planes and M-16s in 13 months and the good guys won." Far from it. This is a thoughtful story line with plausible occurrences. The characters are enjoyable and realistic. During the early phases of book 1 I had some "draggy" spots, but they quickly gave way to a pretty fast pace that never lagged. Well worth your time to read!

I've read all three books and look forward to number four. Character development has been first class. Story line is also first class. So often in series like this, the following books drop in quality, but not in this case. Thanks to the author for sharing with his readers. Looking forward to part four.

Buy the kindle edition, skip the first 80% and read the last 20% of this book...Most of this book covers people doing mundane tasks explained from different viewpoints in excruciatingly boring details, and the small amount of actual science found in the first two books is nonexistent here!

Solid continuation of the series. I'm a big fan of this type of story. This was probably my least favorite of the 3 books, but still good. I feel that the the POV's from the enemy go on too long. I find myself skimming some of that. My favorite part of the story is when the MC is working on inventions, building his business, and changing the world around him. In this book, that kind of took a backseat. The author did reference it, but it felt more like the MC was just running through a checklist. He

didn't really get involved. He just gave out ideas to others, and quickly moved on to other things. It was a long book, but still felt rushed. Still, very good series, and can't wait for the next one.
