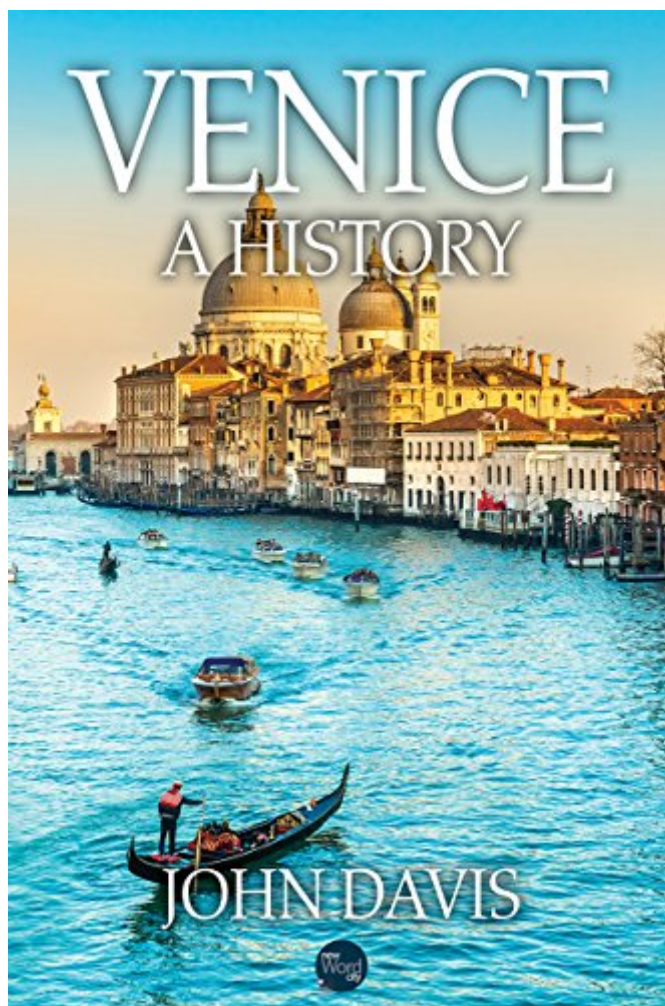

Very cursory history, with a lot of focus on art and architecture. The rise of the empire, its changes and fall is barely dealt with, the why of Venice's greatness is mentioned but not explored. Serious students need to look somewhere else.
