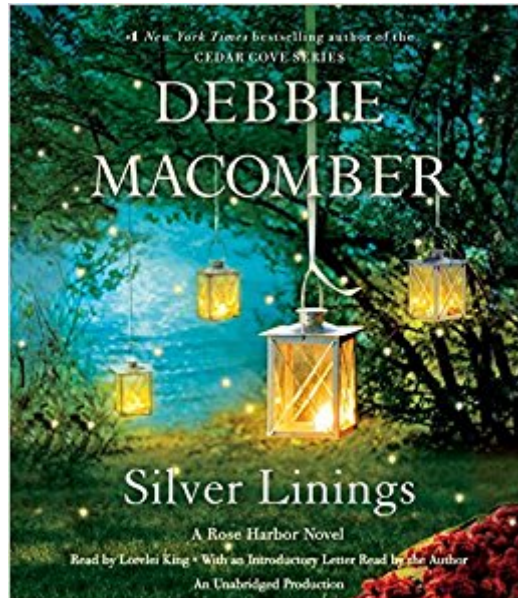




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Silver Linings: A Rose Harbor Novel

The inn has a couple as guests from another of DM's books (New York reporter/Alaska author recluse). It is fun to 'catch up' with other characters. There is also an update on guests from previous books in this series. Her two new guests have come to attend a 10 year high school reunion. One to release anger at a boy who caused her pain and embarrassment and the other to apologize to a boy that she had to dump. At one point Coco bumps into a man that she does not remember and I am sure that many readers were shouting 'Hudson'. Their stories continue after they leave the inn and were

a little more believable to follow.

I've read many of the reviews and I've both smiled and shaken my head at the polarity of differences in reviews. What I can say is this -- a reader approaches a book from their perspective, and takes from it what they are able and willing to absorb. While part of this setting was a high school reunion, and simple in some people's opinions, the story is one of multiple relationships with healing and hope as an overall theme. To me, that's beautiful. I loved the story of the unlikely partnering of characters, especially our lead and her handyman. As a younger suddenly-made widow myself, I have to laugh at these fictitious loves but like much literature, it has given me a flashlight beam on the possibilities way up ahead. I hear the message, "who are we to limit God?" I don't know what widows DM interviewed for her research, but many of her widow characterizations were spot-on for me. While there are only so many illustrations possible in a paperback novel, hers were authentic and relational and for that I am thankful. Ultimately, this was a one day cover-to-cover read. I laughed and I cried, I related to characters and I shook my head at others. The examples of forgiveness, risk-taking and life sought after a loved one's death were well worth the time and money of this book. Thank you, Debbie.
