

Synopsis

This is a book that I originally wrote for my own children. It introduces stranger danger through a story told through the eyes of a child. The story raises this subject in what I hope is a not particularly frightening way, yet with a clear message and an opportunity for more discussion - not the end of the discussion on this important subject but, I hope, a good beginning.

Great book for helping kids understand the danger of strangers. Even if young ones don't fully understand the depth of the danger, if they come across a situation such as the one depicted, I am

quite certain they will think about what was said in the book before making a decision such as to get into a car with someone. This is really a must read for all children.

This will be too long to keep my almost 4 year old's attention. I will probably hang on to it until he is 5 and then read it. Still looking for a book appropriate for his age.
