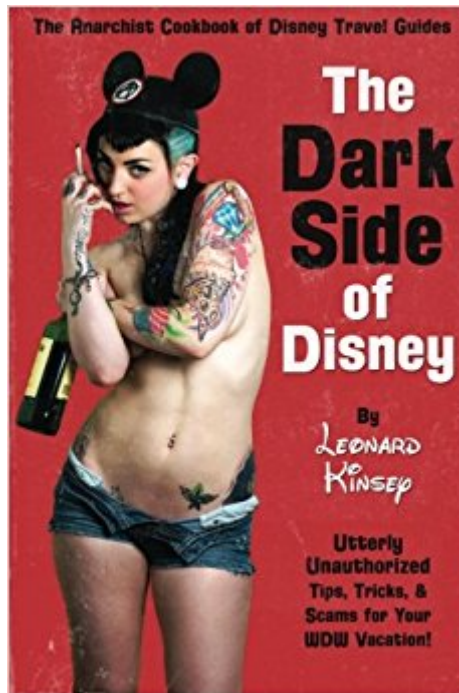

Have read just about all the Disney books that are out there and have been over 18 times in 20 years so lot of this stuff was not new. I had been in the underground tunnels for tours and have gotten lost driving around in "employees only areas". Over all the book had some funny moments

and some interesting experiences about someone that does not "follow the rules". I don't agree with his statement about the Disney meal plan as I have told people the food was one of the reasons I love Disney World so much. I have made trips without the meal plan and with it and have saved more money eating at the same places with the meal plan. Where else or you going to be able to eat two meals a day on vacation for basically 16.50.. Not at any resort I have ever seen and the idea about bringing your own food. Just one more thing to lug around the park. I eat at the parks because I want to spend as much time as possible and while you might get to eat cheaper "offsite" it's not worth the lost time to head offsite for meals. There was one thing he left off IF you have even the slightest idea you are going to make more than one trip a year then the money for an annual pass is well spent. It works out that you come out ahead the first time you step into a park on the 2nd Trip. And it's a no-brainer if you make 3 trips in a year.
