I'm so excited to use this book to try some of these new games, like The Human Christmas Tree, or Indoor Bowling! I suggest everyone give this book a chance, especially if you have little ones!

I found Hollister's insights on family game choices to be a helpful tool in planning for evenings at home. Game nights have always been central to our family's way of staying connected, but we have occasionally hit a few ruts where we end up playing the same game repeatedly for days on end. This book introduced me to several games I simply hadn't heard before. One section that I found to be particularly useful was in chapter three (Group Games). There, Hollister explains how a story-telling game might be constructed. If you are lacking in board games already, they can sometimes be a steep purchase. Having a game centered on telling a story is a fantastic way to engage with your children's creativity and imagination. I would definitely suggest this book to any wishing to spice up their game nights at home or outside!
