

She loves lifting the flap and saying what she sees under the flaps very loudly. She feels very good about herself when she can read a few words at a time. This is a great book for little readers. I see that it helps her gain her confidence. Highly recommended for new readers. Cute, short stories that are great for bedtime. She likes this book in particular as she takes a bath right before bed.

The baby loves all of Karen Katz' book and this one is perfectly timed for baby's bath time every evening. Great book, flaps could be more sturdy, but we buy the books anyhow.

Our 8 month old granddaughter loves this book - she very quickly learned how to pick up the flaps and then she giggles! We enjoy reading to her and would recommend all of Karen Katz books.

Great board book for little ones. The flaps make the book even better as your child lifts the flaps to find a surprise under it! Pictures are colorful and holds child's interest. We have a few of these and they are all great.

We have several Karen Katz books. We like many of them, but I'm just not a big fan of this one. The story line seems a bit boring and the contents seem to be too random. My 7-month-old isn't particularly into it either.

My 15 month old son's favorite books are the ones that he can interact with - and Karen Katz books are some of the best. The colors are bright, the images are clear, and the flip flaps are sturdy and easy enough to lift while still requiring him to pinch his fingers and pay attention. The text is large enough and easy to pay attention to - the words are clear and perfect for his age.

The flaps are too big and get bent in between the pages and my 17 month tries to crumple them. Also she chewed the corner a bit and it completely came apart in her mouth.

Karen Katz books are my son's favorite! I have been reading these to him since he was 3 months old and now he is 1 1/2 and still LOVES them. I recommend them to all moms!
