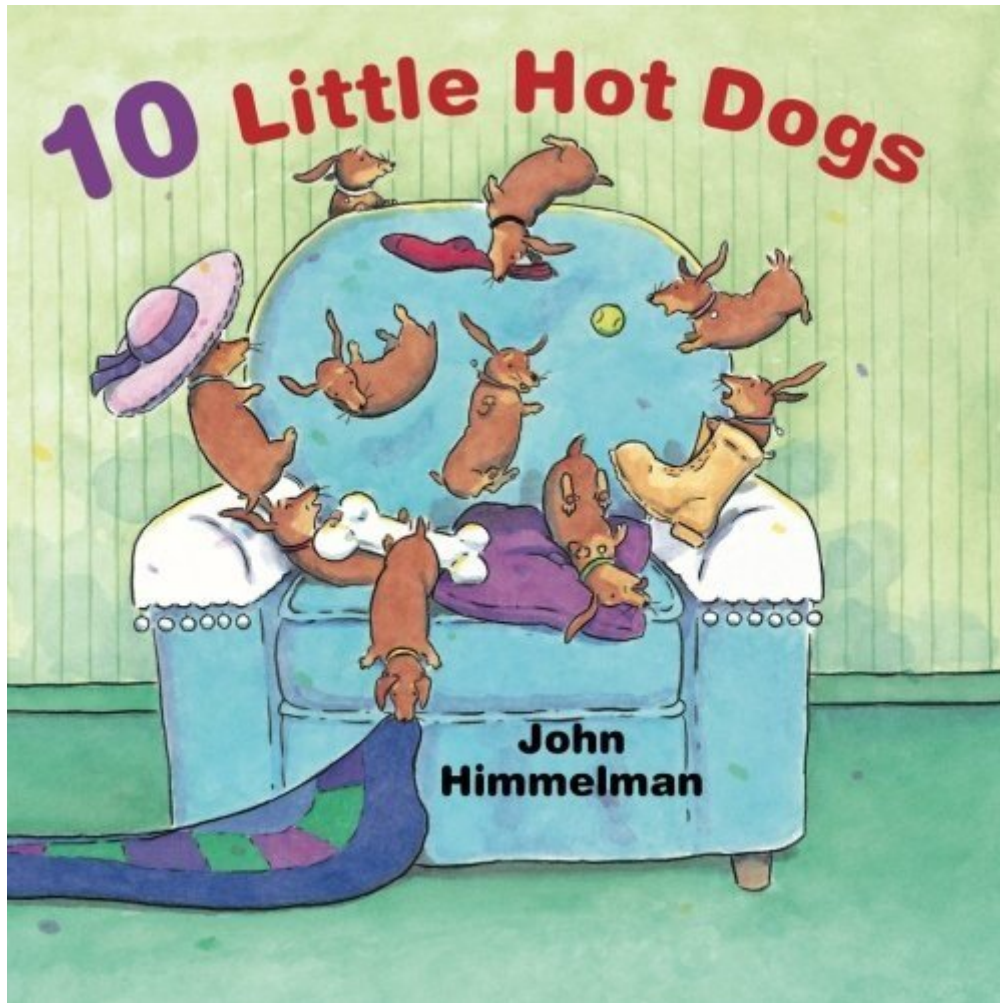

She acts just the doxies in the book! This is a wonderful story for the emergent reader that teaches counting in an easily accessible manner. Children will fall in love with the Dachshund characters and will enjoy counting them throughout the

book.

I liked this book, such cute illustrations and funny little details, like when one dachshund was hopping around in a boot. Made me chuckle, and my nephew enjoyed the book as well. He preferred another dachshund book that I ordered to this one, but a 4-year old can sometimes be choosy. I still enjoyed it.

I think the pictures are cute, but the book is really not easy to read on my kindle fire. Each screen shows the book laid open showing two pages at a time...which would be fine if the story lined up..but it doesn't. So, you start reading about the 8 little dogs on the right side of the page & then turn the page on the kindle to see the rest of the lines about the 8 dogs. Also, I guess I expected it to rhyme, but it doesn't & I think it reads choppy.
