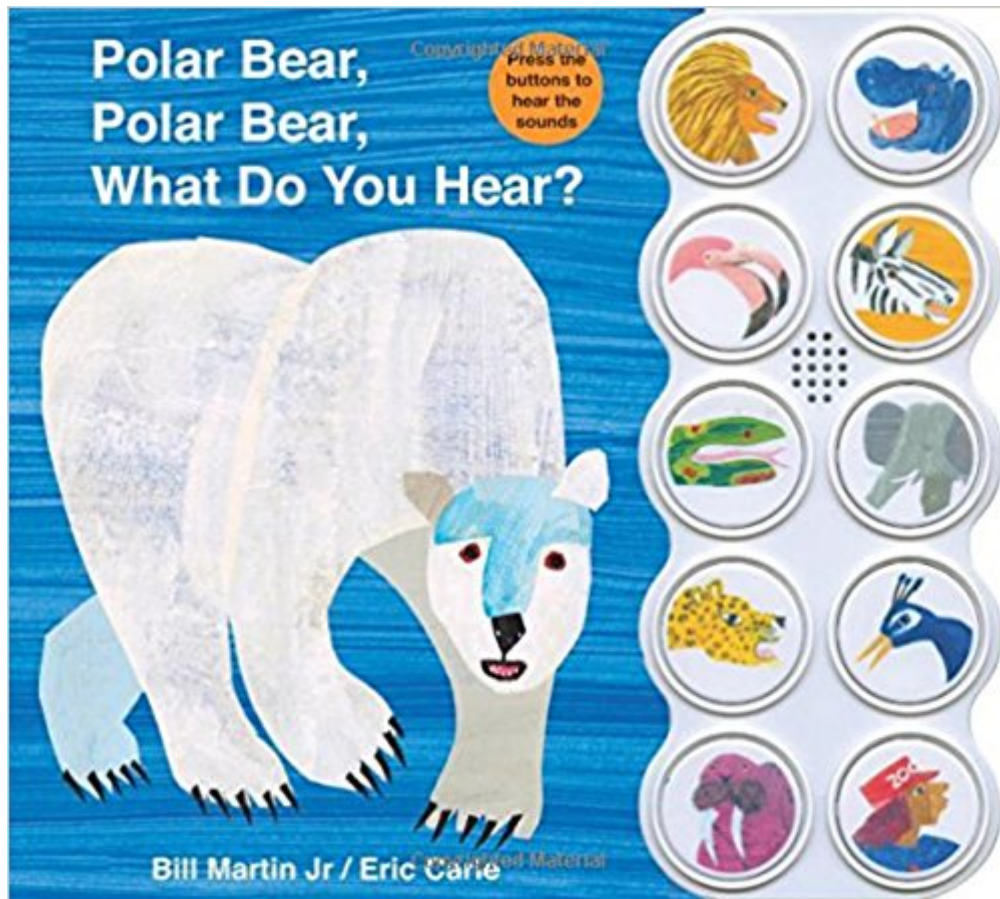

We love this book, my young children(3,2,1) all love it and TRY to take turns pushing them ;-)They love the repetitive sounds of the writing, the funny sounds each of the animals make and the fact that it's all about animals.HOWEVER the title of the book is POLAR BEAR POLAR BEAR, so why is there no polar bear button? I know this may be a minor issue, when my 3yr old asks this question, it makes you wonder why the publishers didn't think of it.Overall a good book with great, bright Eric Carle illustrations, would be 5-stars if there was a polar bear button :-)

Great book for children who like to interact with a book. Has held up well. My grandchild loves to push buttons and hear them make noise or talk so has quite a few of these and this is one of the better ones. He likes animals.

My 18 yr old LOVED this book as a child, my 4 yr old read this book and now my 2 yr old is obsessed with it. Being 18yrs old, my original book was falling apart and missing the cover. Time to replace it, and I was getting a raspy voice having to do the animal sounds over and over and over... I saw this and it was the answer to my prayers! I no longer have to make the noises!!! My 2 yr old adores this. I wish I could give it 4 3/4 stars since the book does not include a polar bear button. I know that the story does not begin with the polar bear making noise but the last page has all the children making the animal noises and we are unable to listen to a polar bear. Disappointing yes, but not disappointing enough to rate this a 4. I'm extremely happy with this.

Great book, it keeps my daughter entertained for hours. She likes the sounds, but Im not sure they are too realistic. Strangely, there is no Polar Bear sound and the book is called Polar Bear.

Overall my baby seems to enjoy this book and most of the animal sounds are okay...not totally accurate but acceptable. However, I'm not sure if ours is defective but the boa constrictor actually growls like a tiger or lion or something. It's really not even remotely close to the hissing sound mentioned in the book. Not that boa constrictors typically hiss even, but at least it should sound like a hiss and not a loud growl.

I purchased this book for students in my classroom (with multiple disabilities). We read this book and the students were able to push the buttons to hear the animal sounds. It was very interactive and the kids loved it. Weread this book over and over and the kids did not tire of reading and the sounds played well throughout.

My 1 year old is obsessed with this book. He loves it so much and follows along while I read. He loves helping push the buttons. I highly recommend this book!
