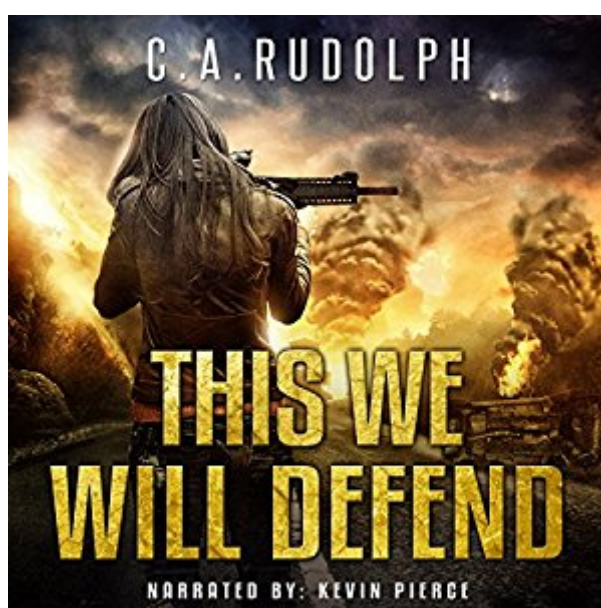


The book was found

This novel is a skillful blend of good entertainment and also thought-provoking ideas and information. If you haven't read the first novel in this series, which is an excellent book, it's okay because this novel stands fully on its own. The ending is also that of a complete work and not one of those disgusting cliffhangers one encounters so often these days in independently published fiction. The characters are well-developed and gradually take on the substance of real people you might know or work with every day. Even the villains are believable, with sufficient development to make their actions and motives believable. The novel has a number of interesting characters that can easily form the basis for future novels - something I hope the author is already working on. The dialog is excellent and is used to effectively move the plot along and to explore ideas and philosophy that are relevant to the story and not presented in a burdensome manner. My only criticism of the dialog, and it's a minor one, is that I prefer the word "said" in most cases rather than more descriptive words. The dialog and its place in the action is plenty to paint the picture, mood, tone, etc. in the mind of the reader, and those more descriptive substitutes for "said" can be a bit distracting. I find it amusing that some people seem offended by the minor profanity in the dialog. The novel is actually quite PG with respect to everything from realistic but pretty mild language, to reasonable descriptions of violence that could be easily described far more graphically, and even mild descriptions of romantic interests with nothing approaching R-rated behavior. Like the first book in this series, although there are some characters motivated by religious faith, it is a part of the plot and definitely not a preachy sort of thing. Finally, unlike a good novel that only serves its purpose as enjoyable entertainment, this one has some very important insights that are likely to make anyone who is awake while reading continue thinking after the book is closed or the kindle is turned off. For example, I think every parent of children teenaged or younger should read Chapter 15, and every teenager should read it also. No spoilers here, though, so buy it and enjoy reading!
