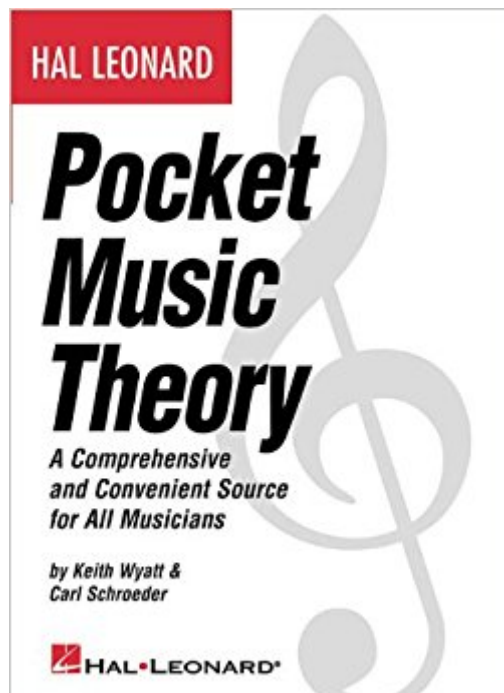




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Hal Leonard Pocket Music Theory: A Comprehensive And Convenient Source For All Musicians

This book goes a lot farther than a lot of the other Music Theory books I looked at, when I read about 2/3rds of the book, it really started getting out there in terms of practical theory.

In it, you will find succinct, yet comprehensive explorations of everything from basic principles of music (reading and notation) to chord, scale, and even basic song formation.
