

My objective review: I thoroughly enjoyed the views of Mr Davis and the book, and I would suggest to other readers to keep the Led Zeppelin discography at hand so that they can enjoy the songs as they are commented on by the author. I can understand why some of the band members, and people that were involved with Led Zeppelin could be unhappy with what was written: warts, tarts, and all.

I read this book years ago, it has a lot of good information about Zeppelin but also a lot made up junk that Richard Cole came up with to make himself sound better. What a shame it could have been more factual. Better to read *When Giants Walked the Earth*. The Page by Page pictograms is excellent but would you expect anything else from Mr. Page?

I personally would give this a 5 star, based on when I read it years ago -- an influential rock classic book. However, I bought a copy for my girlfriend, and she said it's just OK, she liked the *Motely Crue* book better (the one by Neil Strauss, which is excellent by the way). She would prefer a more personalized account, with the input and thoughts of the actual Zeppelin members.

A great book, covering the full careers of Jimmy Page, Robert Plant, John Paul Jones, and John Bonham, depicting Jimmy's rise as a godfather of the London music scene, his creation of a real supergroup, how he discovered Robert Plant and John Bonham, and all the amazing adventures with visionary manager Peter Green, who protected the band and helped them earn decent money. There's tales of groupies and sex, of how Jimmy Page and Ron Wood swapped wives/girlfriends one fine day, and then also his slide into drug use. Robert Plant's life is nicely fleshed out, mentioning the tragedy of his son's death at age six and also the terrible car crash that almost robbed him of the use of his legs. The chaos of destroyed hotel rooms is there, exploding TVs and shark invasions, as well as tales of robberies, beatings and arrests. There is also a good post-breakup section that talks about Robert and Jimmy's stormy relationship, as well as the alienation of John Paul Jones. Of course, the band did play together in 2007, which is described in the book, and is the latest word in Led Zeppelin, so far at least.

Really gives you an insight into what the times were like and the fun and not so fun journeys of being in a rock band.
