

This contemplative book takes readers through the creation process from the first bright idea to the finished product. The making of the toy is the focus, but the father/daughter partnership shows the role children can play. Similar to Ali Mitgutsch's *From Idea to Toy* (Carolrhoda, 1988), this book has full-color photographs that lend a touch of reality, documenting step-by-step a complicated procedure.
